

FDCM Gorewada Zoo (FGZ) Limited is a Government of Maharashtra enterprise, responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Balasaheb Thackeray Gorewada International Zoological Park (BTGIZP) and the Wildlife Rescue Centre at Gorewada.
